



FOUNDATION OF QUEBEC CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS Graduate scholarship program

The Foundation of Quebec Chartered Accountants is committed to promoting academic excellence. That is why each year the Foundation awards \$57,000 in scholarships to students who have opted for the CA designation and are registered in the Professional Education Program (PEP) of the Ordre des comptables agréés du Québec (Ordre). The PEP is an integral part of a graduate diploma program offered by eleven Quebec universities.

Because the selection process is based on academic achievement, students do not need to send an application to the Foundation. The graduate diploma scholarship program calls for close cooperation between the universities and the Foundation, since university representatives are the ones who give the Foundation the names and contact information of the students with the highest cumulative GPA in the PEP or undergraduate program. Undergraduate students receive their scholarship only once they are registered in the Ordre's Professional Education Program. **Only those students who are registered in the PEP or in their third year of the undergraduate program are eligible for these scholarships.**



The scholarships are usually awarded to students during a ceremony organized by their university or its foundation and attended by a representative of the Foundation of Quebec CAs or regional group. Scholarships are awarded between April 1 and March 31, which coincides with the Foundation's fiscal year.
