

Review of complaints

The Review Committee

If, after receiving a request for an inquiry into a member's conduct, the Syndic decides not to lodge a complaint with the Committee on Discipline, the person who requested the inquiry may seek an opinion from the Review Committee.

Timing

The application for review must be addressed to the secretary of the Review Committee within thirty (30) days of the date of receipt of the Syndic's decision.

Review Committee's decision

Under section 123.5 of the *Professional Code*, after reviewing the record, the Committee may, in the opinion it gives:

- decide that there is no cause to lodge a complaint with the Committee on Discipline. In this case, the plaintiff may lodge a complaint with the Committee on Discipline on his own initiative;
- suggest that the Syndic or Assistant Syndic complete his inquiry;
- suggest that the Syndic refer the record to the *Professional Inspection Committee*;
- decide that there is cause to lodge a complaint and suggest the name of a person who, acting in the capacity of Syndic, could lodge the complaint.
