Admission Requirements

Québec applicants must have successfully completed a two-year pre-university program in a CEGEP and qualify for a Diploma of Collegial Studies (DEC) or the equivalent. Applicants who have completed a three-year professional program in a CEGEP or have obtained a French or International Baccalaureate are also eligible for consideration. CEGEP profile: Mathematics 201-103, 201-105 - Economics 383-920, 383-921 - Computer Literacy.

Language Proficiency

While the language of instruction at Concordia is English, most assignments and examinations may be submitted in French. Students whose first language is neither French nor English must demonstrate language proficiency prior to their admission to Concordia. They will ordinarily be exempt from pre-admission English tests if they meet one of the following criteria:

1. They hold a Québec Diploma of Collegial Studies (or its equivalent from an English or French language school system).
2. They have obtained an O-level pass in English language in the General Certificate of Education, or the equivalent.

If none of these criteria is met, a student whose first language is other than English or French must write a required English test.

Differentiating Characteristic
