

**Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the diplomas issued  
by designated teaching establishments which give access  
to permits or specialist's certificates of professional corporations**

Professional Code  
(R.S.Q., c. C-26, S. 184, 1<sup>st</sup> par., subpar. a)

1. The Regulation respecting the diplomas issued by designated teaching establishments which give access to permits or specialist's certificates of professional corporations, made by Order in Council 1139-83 dated 1 June 1983, replacing the revised regulation (R.R.Q., 1981, c. C-26, r. 1) and having effect from 1 August 1982, amended by the Regulations made by Orders in Council 429-83 dated 17 February 1983, 1592-84 dated 4 July 1984, 1645-84 dated 11 July 1984, 2193-84 and 2194-84 dated 3 October 1984, 2755-84 dated 12 December 1984, 672-85 dated 3 April 1985, 268-86 dated 12 March 1986, 737-87 dated 13 May 1987, 866-88 dated 8 June 1988, 890-89 dated 14 June 1989, 1292-89 dated 9 August 1989, 201-90 dated 21 February 1990, 142-91 dated 6 February 1991, 1231-91 dated 4 September 1991, 1726-91 dated 11 December 1991, 320-92 dated 4 March 1992, 796-92 dated 27 May 1992, 1099-92 dated 22 July 1992, 1647-92 dated 11 November 1992 and 1653-92 dated 11 November 1992, is further amended by inserting the following after section 1.28:

“**1.29** The following diplomas awarded by the teaching establishments listed below give access to the permit issued by the Ordre des comptables agréés du Québec:

- (a) Bachelor of Business administration (B.B.A.), obtained upon completion of the Concentration in Accounting program, at Bishop's University;
- (b) Bachelor of Commerce (B. Comm.), obtained upon completion of the Bachelor of Commerce program, Major in Accountancy, at Concordia University;
- (c) Bachelier en administration des affaires (B.A.A.), obtained upon completion of the baccalauréat en administration des affaires program, specialization Sciences comptables, at Université Laval;
- (d) Bachelor of Commerce (B. Comm.), obtained upon completion of the Bachelor of Commerce program, Major in Accountancy, at McGill University;
- (e) Bachelier en administration des affaires (B.A.A.), obtained upon completion of the baccalauréat en administration des affaires program, concentration Comptabilité professionnelle, at the École des Hautes Études Commerciales de Montréal;
- (f) Bachelier en administration des affaires (B.A.A.), obtained upon completion of the baccalauréat en sciences comptables program at the Université du Québec, offered at the Université du Québec à Chicoutimi;
- (g) Bachelier en administration des affaires (B.A.A.), obtained upon completion of the baccalauréat en sciences comptables program, specialization Expertise comptable, at the Université du Québec, offered by the Université du Québec à Hull;
- (h) Bachelier en administration des affaires (B.A.A.), obtained upon completion of the baccalauréat en sciences comptables program at the Université du Québec, offered by the Université du Québec à Montréal;
- (i) Bachelier en administration des affaires (B.A.A.), obtained upon completion of the baccalauréat en sciences comptables program at the Université du Québec, offered by the Université du Québec à Rimouski;

- (j) Bachelier en administration des affaires (B.A.A.), obtained upon completion of the baccalauréat en sciences comptables program at the Université du Québec, offered by the Université du Québec à Trois-Rivières;
  - (k) Bachelier en administration des affaires (B.A.A.), obtained upon completion of the baccalauréat en sciences comptables program at the Université du Québec, offered by the Université du Québec en Abitibi-Témiscamingue;
  - (l) Bachelier en administration des affaires (B.A.A.), obtained upon completion of the baccalauréat en administration des affaires program, concentration en Comptabilité, at the Université de Sherbrooke.+
2. Schedule I to the Regulation is amended by striking out the words "Ordre des comptables agréés du Québec".
  3. This Regulation came into force on June 10, 1993.
